Rhode Island Interscholastic League Foundation Monsignor Robert Newbold Grant Application

PURPOSE:

The Rhode Island Interscholastic League [RIIL] has identified sportsmanship, character, education and leadership as primary tools in the development among our high school student-athletes.

As a measure to enhance these qualities in our member schools, the RIIL Foundation is designed to provide funding to our member high schools that focus on creating programs with specific, measurable goals to ensure that sportsmanship becomes a primary component in the activities of the school applying for funding. Other foundation purposes are:

1. To facilitate the educational activities of the RIIL and its member schools.
2. To serve and promote RIIL high school interscholastic athletics and activity programs.
3. To develop a model curriculum of citizenship skills which can be incorporated into our high school interscholastic sports instruction and other activities.
4. To promote the model curriculum of citizenship skills through student-athletes leadership conferences and training sessions for coaches and officials.
 - To provide information – through conferences, publications and other means – to high school administrators, coaches, teachers and students concerning the educational benefits realized by students' participation in high school sports.

**The Deadline for submitting Monsignor Robert Newbold Grant Applications is
December 4, 2009.**

MONSIGNOR ROBERT NEWBOLD GRANT GUIDELINES:

1. Priority will be given to activities that:
 - a. will impact the greatest number of student-athletes.
 - b. involve multiple schools and emphasize cooperative activities among schools.
 - c. are sustained over time
 - d. are supported with matching funds from businesses, parent organizations, booster clubs, etc.
2. Funds may not be used to support political activity or attempts to influence legislation.
3. Grants will be based upon the merit of the applications submitted and will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
4. The grant is not designed to support ancillary activities such as programs, ads or special events not related to the purpose(s) of the Monsignor Robert Newbold Grant.

6. Applicants will be notified by mail.
