LIVE INFORMED

Appearance & Performance Enhancing Substances

- Only 19% of adults recognize that youth-related HGH and anabolic steroid use is an issue
- Almost 1.5 million kids admit to using anabolic steroids



Nutrition & Dietary Supplement Safety

- 12.3 million youth use dietary supplements

LIVE INFORMED

HUMAN GROWTH HORMONE (HGH)

- 11% of high school students admit use (*Partnership for Drug-Free Kids 7/2014*)
- 12% of boys and 9% of girls admit use
- 15% of African Americans teens, 13% of Latin American teens and 9% of Caucasian teens admit use, which equates to 2 million high school students!

ANABOLIC STEROIDS

- 7% of high school students admit to using anabolic steroids (*Partnership for Drug-Free Kids 7/2014*)
- 21% of gay and bi-sexual boys admit anabolic steroid use (*Pediatrics Magazine – Harvard Study, 2/2014*)

DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS

- 18-25% are spiked with anabolic steroids or other banned substances
- 35% of middle school and high school students take a protein supplement (University of Minnesota Study, 2012)- that's 9.4 million students!
